

The below guide outlines the new workflow to find and select a support service.


Find support services

For each section of Hauora, you can view support services listed on the service directory that may support the goals of the person.


To view available services, select 'See more services'



Next, refine your search by selecting all relevant support categories




To view the services available under each support category, click 'Select Organisation'



Filter Services


Services will be listed alphabetically by default.
